How many people are needed for *Under the Big Top*?

Under the Big Top is intended for 12 to 15 guests – plus one host (the game coordinators). The step-by-step guide explains which characters to omit if you have fewer than 15 guests (you do need at least 12). Here's how this works:

Number of guests	Male characters	Female characters	Characters that can be played by anyone

How does *Under the Big Top* work?

Under the Big Top runs over the course of four or so hours and is particularly suited to a buffet meal. The host is the Circus Hand, and acts as organizer, responsible for making sure everything runs smoothly. The host does not count towards the minimum or maximum number of players.

The guests are contestants, crew, guests and locals with their own goals. How they choose to achieve those goals is entirely up to them. *Under the Big Top* is an evening of blackmail!

Under the Big Top contains mature plot themes and is suitable for older kids only.
