## Extract from the HADS Articles of Association

## 3. Admission of New Members

To propose a new member, an official HADS Membership Proposal Form must be submitted to the Membership Officer. Each proposal must include a proposer and a seconder. If no current board member objects, the candidate will be formally accepted into HADS and granted full membership privileges. (For HADS Membership Proposal Forms, please contact the Membership Officer.)

## 7. Election of Board Members

Board members are elected through a vote by the HADS membership at a duly convened meeting. To be eligible for election, candidates must submit their names to the Membership Officer, who will then announce all candidates prior to the vote. Each full\* member is entitled to two votes, which may be allocated to two different candidates or both to the same candidate. Votes must be submitted using the official *HADS Board Election Voting Forms*. In the event of a tie, all candidates with equal votes will be elected to the board.

\* Full members are those who have been members of HADS for more than a month.
