How does Arabian Nights work?

Arabian Nights has been written for 18 to 24 guests – plus the host or coordinator. The step-by-step guide explains which characters to omit should you have fewer than 24 guests (you do need at least 18, however). Here's how that works:

Arabian Nights runs over the course of three or four hours and is particularly suited to a buffet meal. One person is the Genie, and acts as organizer and coordinator, responsible for making sure everything runs smoothly and that all the guests have the information they need.

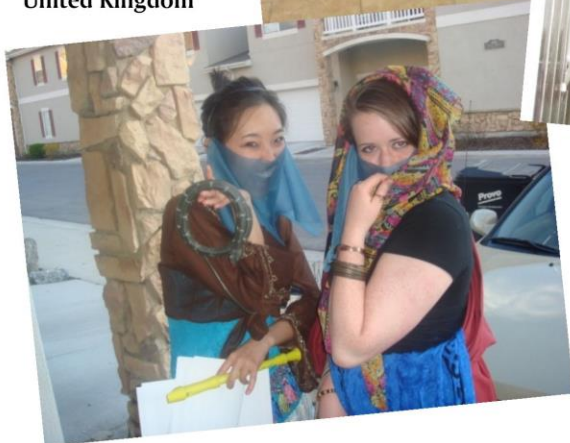
