The characters and the plots are the same, so if your guests have previously played ***Reunion with Death***, they'll know the secrets of ***Christmas Reunion with Death*** too! The difference is that ***Christmas Reunion with Death*** is written specifically for a Christmas setting, while ***Reunion with Death*** is suitable for any time of year.

How many people are needed for *Christmas Reunion with Death*?

Christmas Reunion with Death is for 6 to 9 players. Someone needs to coordinate and organize (host) the game – they can either be in addition to the other players, or they can play one of the characters themselves. The step-by-step guide explains which characters to omit if you have fewer than 9 players (you do need at least 6, however). Here's how this works:

Number of players	Male characters	Female characters	Characters that can be played by anyone
6	2	2	2
7	2	2	3
8	3	3	2
9	3	3	3

And if you have even more guests, we have a few free extra characters for *Christmas Reunion with Death* available on our website.

How does *Christmas Reunion with Death* work?

Christmas Reunion with Death runs for three or four hours and suits a buffet meal. The host can either play the role of the Hotel Manager (game coordinator), or if they prefer they can instead play one of the characters. In either case, they are responsible for making sure everything runs smoothly and that all guests have the information they need. The Hotel Manager does not count toward the minimum or maximum number of players.

The characters are all locked in at the Sturner Palace Hotel, to try and identify the murderer of Mikolette Lukanis. They each have their own goals, and how they achieve these goals is up to them. *Christmas Reunion with Death* is an evening of high-school grudges, present-day rivalry, and murder!

Playing online

Christmas Reunion with Death has been designed to be particularly straightforward to adapt for play online, via video chat. The game includes instructions for how to use it in this way.
